CONTEST DETAILS:

- **Theme:** "The Art of Saving." All entries should depict the benefits of saving.
- **Eligibility:** Any student grade K-12 attending public or private school in the Santa Clarita Valley.*
- **Media:** Watercolor, acrylic, markers, crayon, pen & ink, construction paper, high resolution electronic graphics, etc. Due to reproduction issues no pencil works can be accepted. All artwork must be an original piece by the artist.
- **Size/Surface:** Artwork must be landscape orientation on paper that is a maximum size of 17 inches wide by 11 inches high.
- **CONTEST DEADLINE is Friday, October 7, 2011 by 6 p.m.**
- Artwork may be delivered to our Santa Clarita Branch by 6 p.m.
- Winners will be selected by a panel of local artists and creative professionals.
- Winning art will be published in All Valley Federal Credit Union's 2012 "Art of Saving" Calendar and will be displayed at a local art display.
- \$100 will be awarded toward the savings account of each of the 13 winning artists.
- \$100 will be awarded to the school attended by the artist.
